NOTIFICATION

MINES AND MINERALS (DEVELOPMENT AND REGULATION) ACT, 1957.

No.DMF-0124/C.R.10/Ind-9.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 9B and sub-section (4) of section 15 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), in its application to the State of Maharashtra and in pursuance of the directions issued by the Government of India under section 20A of the said Act, the Government of Maharashtra hereby, makes the following rules, to amend the Maharashtra District Mineral Foundation (Trust) Rules, 2016, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra District Mineral Foundation (Trust) (**Amendment) Rules, 2024. Hereby specify the number of the amendment in words, unless it is the first amendment in this year.

2. In rule 5 of the Maharashtra District Mineral Foundation (Trust) Rules, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), for sub-rules (1), (2) and (3) the following sub-rules shall be substituted, namely:-

“(1) The management of the District Mineral Foundation Trust shall vest in the Governing Council, which shall consist of all the Trustees of the Trust appointed by the State Government.

The Governing Council shall consist of the Chairman, members and Member-Secretary.

(2) The District Collector of the District shall be the Chairman of the Governing Council and the Managing Committee.

(3) In case there is one Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) in a district, then he shall be the member of the Governing Council.

In case, there are more than one Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) in a district, then all such Members of Parliament (Lok Sabha) in a district having mining affected areas as part of their constituency shall be the members of the Governing council. In case, the constituency of one Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) falls in more than one district then the Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) shall be a member of the Governing Council of District Mineral Foundation Trust of all such districts where mining affected area is a part of his or her constituency;

(3A) The Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha) from a State shall be the member of the Governing Council of District Mineral Foundation of one district selected by him or her. The Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha) shall intimate name of the district selected by him or her to the Secretary in-charge of Mining Department of the State who in turn shall inform the same to the concerned District Magistrate or Deputy Commissioner or Collector as the case may be;

(3B) The Members of Legislative Assembly of the district having mining affected area as part of their constituency shall be the members of the Governing Council. In case, the constituency of one Member of Legislative Assembly falls in more than one district then the Member of Legislative Assembly shall be a member of the Governing Council of District Mineral Foundation Trust of all such districts where mining affected area is a part of his or her constituency;

(3C) The Members of Legislative Council of the State shall be the members of the Governing Council of the District Mineral Foundation Trust of one district selected by them. The Members of Legislative Council of the State shall intimate name of the district selected by them to the Secretary in-charge of Mining Department of the State who in turn shall inform the same to the concerned District Magistrate or Deputy Commissioner or Collector, as the case may be;

(3D) The following Officers shall be the *Ex-Officio* members of the Governing Council:-

(a)	Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad.	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Member,
(b)	Administration officer of the Municipal Corporation or Municipal Council of the mine-affected area within the limits of the Municipal Corporation or Municipal Council.	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Member,
(c)	District Vocation Training Officer.	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Member,
(d)	District Tribal Welfare Officer.	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Member,
(e)	District Health Officer.	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Member,
(f)	Executive Engineer, Zilla Parishad.	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Member,
(g)	District Women and Child Development Officer.	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Member,
(h)	General Manager, District Industries Centre (DIC).	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Member.

(3E) The District Mining Officer shall be the *Ex-Officio* Member-Secretary of the Governing Council.”.

3. In rule 7 of the principal Rules for sub-rules (1) and (2) the following sub-rules shall be substituted, namely:-

- “ (1) The Governing Council shall meet as often as necessary but at least twice in a year;
 (2) The meeting of the Governing Council shall be convened by the Chairperson as per the convenience of the Members of Parliament by giving notice to the members of Governing Council.”.

4. In rule 8 of the principal Rules,-

(i) for sub-rules 3 and (3A) the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“3. The Managing Committee shall consist of the following Members:-

(a)	The District Collector of the District	Chairman
(b)	Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Members
(c)	District Vocation Training Officer	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Members
(d)	District Tribal Welfare Officer	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Members
(e)	District Health Officer	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Members
(f)	Executive Engineer, Zilla Parishad	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Members
(g)	District Women and Child Development Officer	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Members
(h)	General Manager, District Industries Centre (DIC)	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Members
(i)	One representative of Pollution Control Board	<i>Ex-Officio</i> Members
(j)	District Mining Officer	Member-Secretary.”.

(ii) Sub-rule (4) shall be deleted.”.

5. In rule 13 of the principal Rules,-

(i) for sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“(2) At least 70 per cent. of the amount shall be utilized in the directly affected areas and rest maximum 30 per cent. shall be utilized in the indirectly affected areas. (Directly affected mine area shall be an area within 15 k.m. radius from the mine and indirectly affected mine area shall be an area within 25 k.m. radius from the mine).”;

(ii) in sub-rule (3) relating to High Priority areas for the brackets, figure and words “(3) At least sixty percent of the funds available with the Trust” the brackets, figure, letter and words “(3)(A) At least seventy per cent. of the funds available with the Trust” shall be substituted;

(iii) in sub-rule (3) relating to other priority areas for the brackets, figure and words “(3) Upto forty percent of the Trust funds” the brackets, letter and words “(B) Upto thirty per cent. of the Trust funds” shall be substituted.
